

### **34-47 (3) Winter Parking Regulations.**

- a. Residential and agricultural areas. In the event of a snowfall of two inches, parking is prohibited on any public street or alley abutting property zoned as residential or agricultural until after that particular street or alley has been plowed and the snow removed to the curbline regardless of the time of day. Any vehicle parked in the violation of this section may be cited.
- b. General business district. In the event of a snowfall of two inches, parking is prohibited on any public street or alley abutting property that is zoned as general business from the hours of 7:00 pm to 8:00 am or until such street or alley has been cleared to the curbline. Any vehicle parked in violation of this section may be cited.
- c. Central business district. In the event of a snowfall of two inches no person shall park any motor vehicle between the hours of 2:00 am and 6:00 am on any of the streets within the central business district. Parking shall be prohibited until such time as the street has been cleared to the curbline. For the purposes of this article, the central business district is defined below. Vehicles found to be in violation of this article will be ticketed and towed.

River Street from 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue West to 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue East (does not include boat landing).

Main Street from 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue East to 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue West.

Madison Street from 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue West to 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue East.

Wells Street from 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue West to 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West.

1<sup>st</sup> Avenue from River Street to Madison Street.

2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West from River Street to Wells Street

3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue West from Main Street to Wells Street

4<sup>th</sup> Avenue West from River Street to Wells Street

5<sup>th</sup> Avenue West from Main Street to Madison Street

- d. The city shall announce that snow parking regulations are in effect by utilizing the Pepin County Sheriff's Department dispatcher. The city will also make available a telephone hotline number whereby snow parking announcements will be made.
- e. In the event of exceptional weather events, the Durand Police Chief retains the right to issue more restrictive parking regulations on a temporary basis.
